The Regional Neonatal Intensive Care Unit is requesting quilts to cover the isolettes and cribs to help with the babies growth and development. This stimulates the babies' minds, warms their bodies and helps them grow while they are sleeping.

Size: The quilts for the isolettes need to be approximately 34x38.”

Material: The back “under” side of the quilt should be gray fleece. The top can be cotton fabric in any type of print or solid colors. Keeping them soft baby colors is preferred.

No batting is needed as the two layers are sufficient. You can either put a binding around the quilts or stitch right sides together and turn the quilts right side out. Also, some top stitching or scattered ties are needed to hold the layers in place. It's up to you.

If you or your sewing group are not already listed as a Covenant HealthCare Volunteer, please make sure your name, address and email/phone are on the blankets you deliver. The hospital collects volunteer hours and counts handmade items volunteers and the community contributes.
